



2011 RAC Spring Art Exhibition

PROSPECTUS

Where and When:

The Rochester Art Club 2010 Spring Art Exhibition will open to the public on Tuesday, March 29th 2011 at the Arts & Cultural Council of Greater Rochester, 277 North Goodman Street, Rochester, NY 14607. The show will continue through Thursday, April 21 2010, with take down from 3-4 on the 21st.

Awards:

The Best of Show award, Rochester Art Supply Award, six Juror awards, and six Merit awards. The cash award for the Best of Show is \$100, the Rochester Art Supply award is a \$50 gift card and the Juror awards are \$50 each.

Sales:

All sales of paintings are to be handled by the artist. An 8% sales tax is to be collected and handled by the artist (no RAC commission is to be paid). Prices for the paintings will be listed in the program.

Eligibility and Show Rules:

- Entrant must be a Signature member in good standing of the RAC as of September 30, 2010. Pre-registration ONLY and forms must be postmarked by Friday, March 18, 2011. Forms should be sent to Pat Tribastone, 1149 Amberwood Lane, Webster, NY 14580.
- Entries must be created within the last two years and not have been shown at any previous RAC or other juried art show within Monroe County.
- All aspects of entry must be the artist's original work including subject, photography, composition, drawing and painting.
- Entries may not be produced in any instructional class or workshop.
- Two and three dimensional work will be accepted into this exhibition.
- No diptych or triptych paintings, mechanical reproductions, photography, crafts, or computer-generated art. Tasteful nudes will be accepted, pending approval of the Arts & Cultural Council Staff.

- Up to three entries are allowed. There is no size restriction. However, be mindful of the limited gallery space.
- Saw-tooth hangers ARE NOT allowed. All paintings must be well framed, dry, and supported by picture wire only.
- No one except the Show Chairpersons, Club President and judge shall be present during the judging.
- Following the judging, phone calls will be made to those entrants for whom all of their entries were accepted; therefore, called entrants do not have to come in. The calls will be made from 2-2:30 pm. Remember, if you do not get a call, you must come to pick up your work. Pick up for work not accepted into the show will be from 3:00 to 4:00 pm on March 28th.
- The show ends on Thursday, April 21. Paintings should be picked up from 3:00 to 4:00 pm on that date. Paintings should not be picked up earlier than the date and time indicated.
- RAC does not anticipate damage or theft; however, neither The Arts & Cultural Council nor RAC is responsible for damage to, or loss of art works submitted for this exhibit.
